Incision with Laser

Recent advances in technology have helped us in surgery as well. Using Laser technology in surgery is enhancing the surgical care we are able to offer your pet. Laser is simply using the power of a certain wavelength of energy to create an incision. Although it does not completely replace the standard scalpel and scissors, it is a superior technique for many procedures. The Laser makes an incision and stops bleeding at the same time, which can mean a shorter surgical time with less post-operative swelling. It has also been associated with less post-operative pain at the surgical incision. Its uses range from declaw in cats, tumor removal, eye and eyelid surgery, oral surgery, and many others.
